REGULAR MEMBER DUES: \$120.00

DUES MUST BE PAID BY OCT. 31, 2011 for uninterrupted use of range --- Gate combination will be changed Nov. 1, 2011. Please renew early to assure mailing out new cards by that date. November is the grace period for late dues payment without penalty. Members whose renewals are not postmarked by Nov. 30, 2011 will be dropped, and must pay \$120 induction/delinquent fee in addition to the dues to reinstate membership privileges.

SENIOR MEMBER DUES: \$35.00---Senior Members must be 65 years old AND a continuous club member for the past 15 years.

Newsletters will only be mailed to members who specifically request mailing of the newsletter through the Membership Committee to save postal expenses. P.O. does NOT forward newsletters, so you must notify Membership of address changes before 21st of month. Newsletters will be mailed to all members in August with renewal form, and again in the fall with election ballot. **ENG C is polling members about EMAILING THE NEWSLETTERS.** If you want the newsletter emailed to your email please indicate so YES _____ NO _____. If no, then you will be responsible for reading newsletters on the website. Newsletters are at www.engc.us in the MEMBERS ONLY section. The **User Name** is engc and the **Password** is the **current gate combination**.

You must provide phone and email for club records and emergency contact. Privacy is assured if member requests unlisted phone and/or email.

ENG C GENERAL RANGE RULES : READ ALL RULES AND SIGN BELOW.

1. All firearms must be unloaded when transferring them to and from vehicles. No loaded firearms on ENG C property, concealed or otherwise, except on an active firing line after the "load" or "commence firing" command has been given.
2. Targets placed at or near ground level are not authorized without a proper backstop. You must maintain the proper target height to ensure that the projectile hits the desired portion of the vertical berm after passing through the target. Likewise do not fire at any object or target which might cause a ricochet.
3. During a cease fire, remove any magazines, completely unload all firearms, open the actions, and ground or bench all firearms. The use of empty chamber indicators is highly recommended.
4. When anyone is down range, do not handle firearms or any equipment on the benches, or be in the firing line/bench area where firearms are present.
5. NO FULL AUTOMATIC FIRING. NO GUNS BASED ON .50 BMG AMMUNITION. No tracer or armor piercing ammunition is allowed.
6. Projectile escape is one of our greatest dangers. Inadvertent discharge and an uncontrolled muzzle will contribute to this hazard. Always keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.
7. Shoot only at authorized targets. Unapproved targets include: glass, the in-ground target holders, the large number boards (1-15) on the

- north end of the 600 yard range, or steel beams for silhouette stands.
8. No holstered handguns, even if unloaded, except for part of a match or at the pistol complex actively engaged in a practice and following USPSA rules, or under the direct supervision or at the discretion of the range officer.
9. No hunting on range property. No alcohol consumption before or during shooting.
10. No driving off the roads on any of the ranges except when authorized by the match director or range officer.
11. Know where others are on the range at all times. Know and obey all rules, commands, and Range Officer directions.
12. MEMBERS MAY BRING NO MORE THAN 3 SHOOTING GUESTS EACH VISIT. You are responsible for the behavior and safety of your family and guests. Guests must be in the member's presence at all times. THE \$5 GUEST FEE MUST BE PAID FOR EACH SHOOTING GUEST, or for immediate family over age 21, excluding the member's spouse.
13. CLEAN UP ALL BRASS AND STEEL CARTRIDGE CASES (except .22 rim fire), dispose of all trash, remove items brought to the range.
14. Any accident or injuries on range property must be reported to a Range Officer or club official immediately.
